- The Pinellas County Sheriff's Office will be out at the Seminole Recreation Center and landing the helicopter on the soccer field as a demonstration for the Summer Camp.

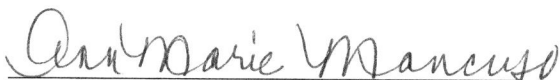

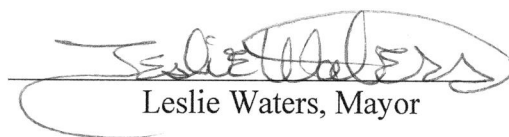
7. **ADJOURNMENT**
